Board of Public Works Regular Meeting July 24, 2018

Edited by the City Clerk for Publication

The complete minutes are on file in the office of the City Clerk and are available for public inspection during regular business hours. A regular meeting of the Board of Public Works was convened in open and public session at 4:15 p.m. on July 24, 2018 in the City Council Chambers. Board members Fossand, Robinson, Coleman, and Porter were present. Also present were Power Plant Superintendent Terrill, Landfill Superintendent Schulte, Electric Superintendent Hinton, Water Superintendent Sisk, Waste Water Superintendent Quicke, City Administrator Dean, City Treasurer and City Clerk Terrill. The public was represented.

Notice of the meeting was given in advance by publication in the Western Nebraska Observer. Notice of the meeting was given to the members and a copy of their acknowledgement of receipt of notice and the agenda is on record at the office of the City Clerk. Availability of the agenda was communicated in advance notice and in the notice to the members. All proceedings hereafter shown were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public.

Meeting called to order at 4:15 p.m. and acknowledged the posted Open Meetings Act poster.

The Board of Public Works reviewed the following items under the consent agenda: (1) Minutes from the regular meeting of June 26, 2018; (2) Claims; (3) Treasurer's Report from June 2018; and (4) Financial Reports from June 2018.

Moved and seconded approve the consent agenda as presented in the packet. Aye: Coleman, Fossand, Robinson and Porter. Nay: None. Absent: Rowley. Motion passed.

Discussion held on the status of the Electrical Rate Study. Dean reported that he has tried to contact Andrew Ross of MEAN but has not been successful as Ross has been on vacation.

Discussion held on the status of the placement of the electrical meter located at 206 W. 9th Street, Kimball, Nebraska that was tabled at the May 22, 2018 meeting. Dean advised the Board that the meter was relocated to the electrical pole in front of the residence last week. Dean went on to say that the property owners are pleased with the current placement of the meter. Moved and seconded to re-

move the status of the electrical meter placement at 206 W. 9th Street, Kimball, Nebraska from the table. Aye: Coleman, Fossand, Robinson and Porter. Nay: None. Absent: Rowley. Motion passed.

Discussion held on the final review and recommendation of the FY 2018/2019 budget. Dean advised the Board that he spoke to the auditor today regarding the proposed utility budget and that the auditor suggested some changes. Moved and seconded to table the recommendation of the FY 2018/2019 budget until the Board can get more information on the rate study. Aye: Coleman, Fossand, Robinson and Porter. Nay: None. Absent: Rowley. Motion passed.

Moved and seconded hold a Budget Workshop on Tuesday August 7, 2018 at 4:15 p.m. Aye: Coleman, Fossand, Robinson and Porter. Nay: None. Absent: Rowley. Motion passed.

Dean reported to the Board that Chris Rowley has resigned from the Board. Dean stated that the Mayor recommend a replacement at the City Council meeting.

Dean reported to the Board on the GIS system stating that there is not a way to fund the system through Economic Development. Dean went on to say that Power Plant Superintendent Terrill is currently building a GIS system for the City.

Dean advised the Board that there are some issues with the Power Plant. Terrill went on to say that after inspection two Catalytic Converters were blown. Terrill reported that one of the radiators at the Plant was repaired but that the repair did not hold. Terrill went on to say that the radiator is needed for the Capability Tests during summer months.

Hinton reported that MEAN came out today to look at the electrical system and that everything looked good.

Quicke reported that he replaced the grinder at the Waste Water Treatment Plant stating the old one was 16 years old and worn down.

Sisk reported that the water tank must be cleaned every 5 years. Sisk went on to say that it was cleaned on the 14th and it went well.

Schulte reported that the Landfill expansion is almost complete.

Next regular meeting will be August 28, 2018 at 4:15 p.m. Moved and seconded to adjourn at 4:58 p.m. Aye: Coleman, Fossand, Robinson and Porter. Nay: None. Absent: Rowley. Motion passed.
